- (a) Short curriculum vitae** (academic qualifications and positions held; major fields of training and research experience; and, in no more than five lines, current research work)
- (b) List of Publications** Mark with an asterisk the five most significant ones. **Do not submit articles and do not list or submit abstracts.**
- (c) Synopsis of proposed work at the FCT** to be written by the applicant on no more than **two A4-sized pages** of single-spaced text set out under the following headings: (i) title; (ii) nature of the work and outline of the experiments proposed; (iii) why it is necessary to go to FCT to perform the work; (iv) why the project will require the time period requested. All references to publications should be given in full. In addition, a timetable of the experimental work to be carried out is to be set out on an extra page.
- (d) A letter supporting your application** from an experienced scientist who knows your work. This should be written on headed paper of your referee's laboratory.
