Abstract and Poster Submission

Requirements to be met for abstract or poster submission:

1. Abstracts or posters must be submitted **before 5th February 2009**, and should include the following information: a) Author's name; b) title of paper or poster; c) e-mail address; d) telephone number and fax number e) institution name and full postal address; f) abstract (500 words maximum) or posters; g) thematic area.
2. Each proposed abstract and/or poster will be assessed by a scientific committee whose decision will be passed on to the authors as soon as possible, and not later than **15th February 2009**. 3. The accepted abstracts of those authors who have registered for the Conference will be published and will be available at the meeting.
4. Abstracts or posters should be written in English.
