### Introduction:

One of the hottest issues in the Egyptian Agricultural Policy is to bridge the gap in per capita animal proteins. Thus, mass production approach occupied the priority when discussing the mechanism(s) for developing the national production of livestock sector. Mass production has success stories in both poultry and fish production sectors. Meanwhile, the majority of small and large ruminants are still raised under extensive system in small herd sizes. Lack of mass production elements (e.g. capitalization of animal production units, medium and long scale breeding programs, housing, animal welfare, milk recording and application of new technologies with particular reference to the expected global warming) represents the major obstacle to reform the livestock production approach (from extensive to mass production). These issues will be discussed in addition under the general theme of the conference. Success stories in poultry and fish production will be discussed as well.

ESAP will organize its 18<sup>th</sup> scientific conference under the theme of *“Sustainable Livestock Industry”*.

### Conference Objectives:

The conference objectives are to:

- 1-Exchange experiences among animal production specialists in Arab World.
- 2- Discuss the constraints of animal production and the way(s) to overcome .
- 3- Capitalize animal production to fulfill per capita animal protein gap

### Language:

The official languages of the conference are Arabic and English with no translation.

### Conference Venue:

The conference events will be held in Hurghada city, Red sea, during the period from November 7 to 10, 2018 in Movie Gate Golden Beach Hotel (five stars).

### Scientific Program:
